ES64C – Neutral Disinfectant Cleaner

BATHROOM CLEANING SCHEDULE

Daily Maintenance Procedures

1. Check and refill dispensers-soap, paper towel, toilet paper, and seat covers.
2. Empty garbage including sanitary napkin receptacles and replace liners.
3. Sweep floor and remove paper, hair, and dust.
4. Add ES920C Bio-Active Bathroom Cleaner to all urinals and toilets and allow to work.
5. Clean mirrors and dispensers with ES920C Bio-Active Bathroom Cleaner.
6. Clean sinks and chrome faucets with ES920C Bio-Active Bathroom Cleaner.
7. Using cotton bowl mop, clean urinals and toilet bowls and base of toilet bowl.
8. Clean toilet seats and spot clean all partition walls with ES920C Bio-Active Bathroom Cleaner.
9. Clean chrome fixtures on all urinals and toilets with ES920C Bio-Active Bathroom Cleaner.
10. Disinfect all touch points with ES64C Neutral Disinfectant Cleaner, spray let dwell 10 minutes and wipe with paper towels.
11. Mop all floors with ES920C Bio-Active Bathroom Cleaner.

Weekly Maintenance Procedures

1. High dust for cobwebs.
2. Dust overhead vents.
3. Dust all petition tops, windowsills, and any high horizontal surfaces.
4. Wipe down all vertical surfaces that are marked by fingerprints with ES64 Disinfectant.
5. Wipe down all petitions with ES64 Disinfectant Cleaner.
6. Pour one 8oz. cup of ES920C Bio-Active Bathroom Cleaner into floor drain.

Monthly Maintenance Procedures

1. Clean all plumbing beneath sink using Franklin Scaleaway.
2. Clean all mineral build-up around faucets, sinks, urinals, and toilet bowls using Franklin Scaleaway.
3. Wipe down all walls with ES64 Disinfectant Cleaner.

CLASSROOM CLEANING SCHEDULE

A. DAILY MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES

1. Check light bulbs and replace as necessary.
2. Clean sink and counter top with disinfectant cleaner. *ES74C*
3. Clean paper towel and hand soap dispensers with disinfectant cleaner and refill dispensers if necessary. *ES74C*
5. Close and lock all windows.
6. Set blinds at half open.
7. Clean glass in door.
9. Empty recycle container and garbage can and replace liner.
11. Dust mop floor.
12. Spot mop floor with neutral floor cleaner, if applicable.
13. Vacuum carpets where applicable.
14. Turn off all lights and lock door.

B. WEEKLY MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES (To be performed along with daily maintenance)

1. High dust for cobwebs.
2. Dust overhead vents.
3. Clean all desktops with disinfectant cleaner. *ES74C*
4. Clean blinds and windowsills.
5. Wipe down all vertical surfaces that are marked by fingerprints with disinfectant cleaner. *ES74C*
6. Clean all windows.
7. Check all rooms and hallways for broken ceiling tiles and replace.

BATHROOM CLEANING SCHEDULE

A. DAILY MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES

1. Check and refill dispensers – soap, paper towel, toilet paper, and seat covers.
2. Empty garbage including sanitary napkin receptacles and replace liners.
3. Sweep floor and remove paper, hair, and dust.
4. Add non-acid bowl cleaner to all urinals and toilets and allow to work.
5. Clean mirrors and dispensers with glass cleaner.
6. Clean sinks and chrome faucets with one-step disinfectant.
7. Using cotton bowl mop, clean urinals and toilets and base of toilet bowl.
8. Clean toilet seats and spot clean all partition walls with one-step disinfectant.
9. Clean chrome fixtures on all urinals and toilets with one-step disinfectant.
10. Trig spray Malodor Counteractant throughout restroom.

B. WEEKLY MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES

(To be performed along with daily maintenance)

1. High dust for cobwebs.
2. Dust overhead vents.
3. Dust all partition tops, windowsills, and any high horizontal surfaces.
4. Wipe down all vertical surfaces that are marked by fingerprints with disinfectant.
5. Wipe down all partitions with disinfectant cleaner.
6. Pour 8 ounces of Malodor Counteractant into floor drain.

C. MONTHLY MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES

(To be performed along with daily maintenance)

1. Clean all plumbing beneath sink using Scaleaway.
2. Clean all mineral build-up around faucets, sinks, urinals, and toilet bowls using Scaleaway.
3. Wipe down all walls with disinfectant cleaner.

GYM CLEANING SCHEDULE

A. DAILY MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES

1. Dry mop floor.
2. Spot mop when necessary.

B. WEEKLY MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES (To be performed along with daily maintenance)

1. Clean under bleachers.
2. Tack floor weekly (or when needed).
3. Scrub with machine as needed.
4. Check lighting.
