## Science Fair: Saturday, March 3, 2018

- Project Boards Optional with Multi-Media Presentation! This year, 8<sup>th</sup> grade students registered for the Chester Science Fair have the option of using their Chrome Book or laptop to augment their spoken presentations to the judges; the project board is "optional" for those students that choose the Multi-Media Presentation. 8th grade students may use a combination of paper, project board, media, and speaking. Scoring metrics do not change. Students are still responsible for everything on the judge sheet. Note: Students may not simply play a video of themselves presenting their project. Students must present their projects "live" and answer questions from the judges. The standard judge time for 8th graders is 15 minutes. Students should allow 5 minutes (out of the 15) for Q & A with the judges.
