- **Project Boards Optional with Multi-Media Presentation!** This year, 8<sup>th</sup> grade students registered for the Chester Science Fair have the option of using their Chrome Book or laptop to augment their spoken presentations to the judges; the project board is "optional" for those students that choose the Multi-Media Presentation. 8th grade students may use a combination of paper, project board, media, and speaking. Scoring metrics do not change. Students are still responsible for everything on the judge sheet. Note: *Students may not simply play a video of themselves presenting their project.* Students must present their projects "live" and answer questions from the judges. The standard judge time for 8th graders is 15 minutes. Students should allow 5 minutes (out of the 15) for Q & A with the judges.
