

Documentation of the Reusable T-Shirt Collections On going throughout the school year. Due to hybrid instruction and lack of printed material handouts. The flyers were sent out via class dojo. ClassDojo is **digital sharing platform** that allows teachers to document the day in class and share that with families via a web browser so that nearly any device can access the content – from a simple smartphone to a laptop computer. If it has a browser, photos and videos can be viewed. All our families in the district are connected to the class dojo platform and the flyer was delivered in 3 languages.

Emails were also sent to all staff at the George L Catrambone School. Collection bins are set up in multiple locations around the building. Students on the GLC Green Team are converting these shirts into reusable bags for the community to use. They have also sent out instructional videos for students to make their own bags at home.




